### 03. **PUBLICATIONS:**

#### (a) **JOURNALS :**

Three issues of "Journal of International Affairs: Vols. 18(2014), 19(2015) and 20(2016) were published. The next issue (Volume-21) is expected to be published by March, 2018. Similarly, four issues of "Bangladesh Journal of Law": Vols. 14(2014), 15(2015) and 16 No. I & II (2016) were published. The next issue (Volume-17) is expected to be published by March, 2018.

#### (b) **BOOK:**

A book, Dr. ASM Ali Ashraf, (Ed) "Intelligence, National Security and Foreign Policy: A South Asian Narrative" was published in 2016. The book is comprised of 397 pages with 23 chapters written by 23 academicians and practitioners from six different countries: Bangladesh, India, Maldives, Germany, the United States of America and Switzerland. These contributors to the edited volume have analyzed different aspects of intelligence and security both from Bangladesh and South Asian perspectives.

#### (c) **FORTH COMING PUBLICATIONS:**

- i) BILIA will publish a book titled "Bangladesh in International Relations- 2017-18. The book is being edited by Dr. Lailufar Yasmin, Professor, Department of International Relations, University of Dhaka and Deputy Director, Research-International Affairs (Part-time), BILIA. It is under process and is expected to be published by April, 2018.
- ii) BILIA will publish another book titled "Case Management in Reducing Casebacklogs: Potential Adaptation from the New South Wales District Court to Bangladesh Civil Trial Courts" written by Ummey Sharaban Tahura, Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sylhet Judge Court. It is under process and is expected to be published by March, 2018.

### 04. **LIBRARY DEVELOPMENT:**

(a) BILIA had acquired around 1800 books for the library. Around 1400 books of these were donated by Justice Muhammad Habibur Rahman and his family members and other 400 books were procured during the last three years i.e from July, 2014 to December, 2017. The total 6,700 books have already been digitally enlisted into the library software, which is also available in the BILIA website. Approximately 1000 books are under process to be digitally enlisted into the library software.

#### (b) **Ph.D THESES ON LEGAL ISSUES BY BANGLADESHI SCHOLARS:**

BILIA has also collected 40 doctoral theses on Law of Bangladeshi scholars for the preservation in the BILIA library for use by Researchers. This is part of our effort to collect doctoral theses on law written by Bangladeshi scholars.

## 05. **WEBSITE DEVELOPMENT:**

BILIA has updated its website with a view to make it more user-friendly, accessible and informative through the drop down menu system. Changes and additions to the website include but are not limited to:

- New information such as lists containing mini biographies of founders, presidents, chairmen and directors of BILIA since its founding year in 1972 have been included in the About section to showcase the distinguished personalities who have led and been involved with BILIA since its inception.
- Author guidelines, note for contributors and published volumes of Bangladesh Journal of Law and Journal of International Affairs have been made clearly accessible.
- An exhaustive list of books published by BILIA has been added to the Publications section.
- A chronological list of articles in journals and newspapers authored by BILIA researchers have been added to the Research section to highlight the different areas of law and international affairs that the BILIA research team are routinely researching into.
- Reports encapsulating the main submissions and discussions by the presenters and speakers in BILIA symposiums have been added to each symposium taking place from 2016.
